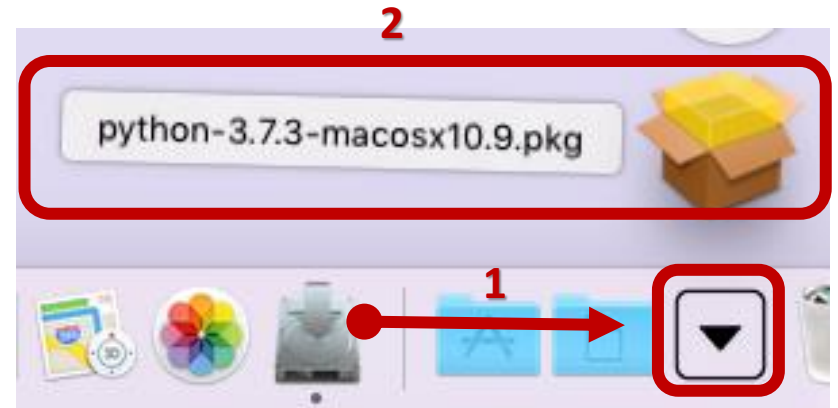
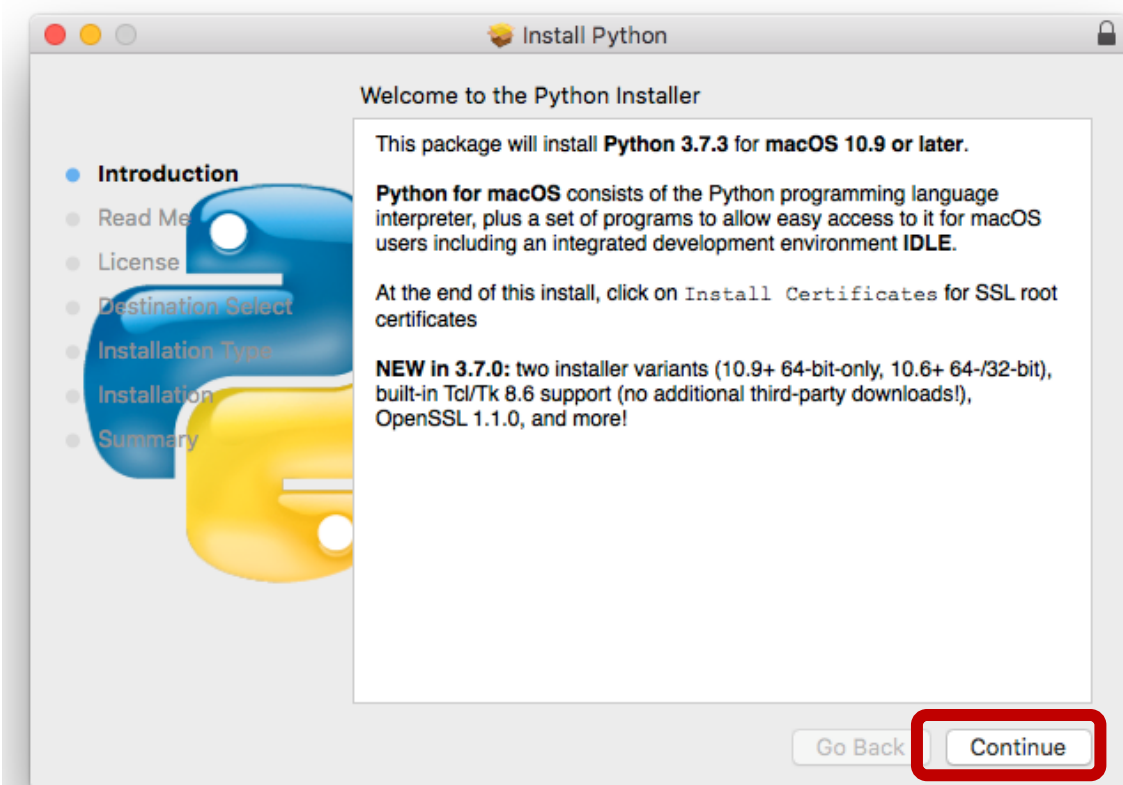

# Python Installation

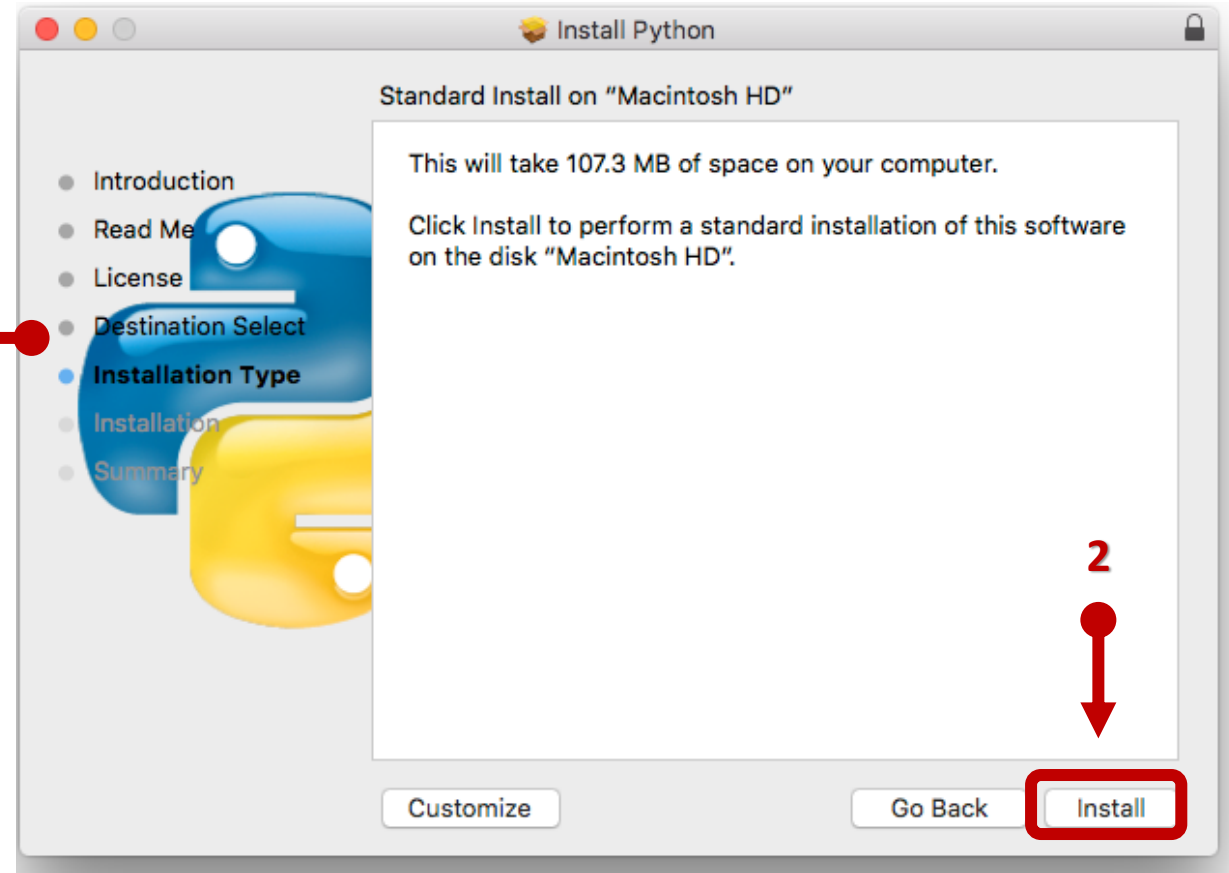
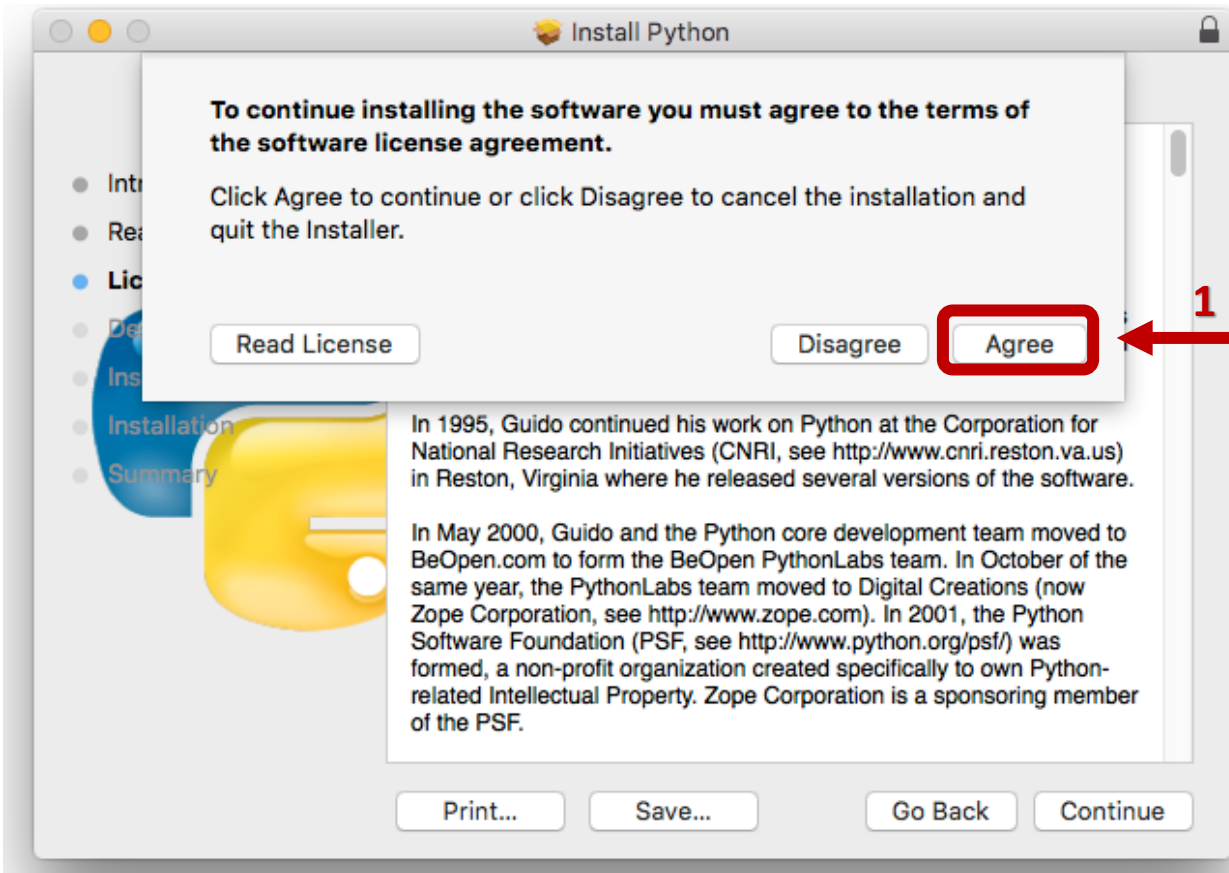
- Open the file you downloaded

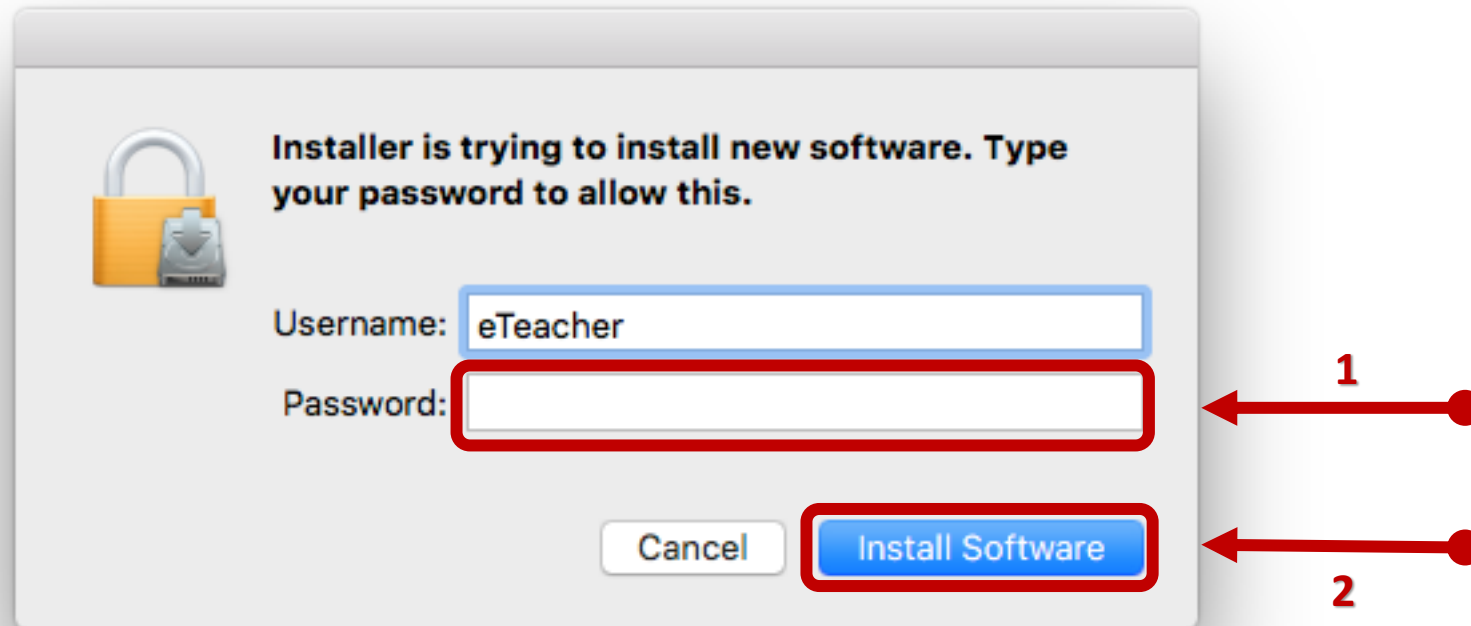
# Python Installation

- Click Install Software



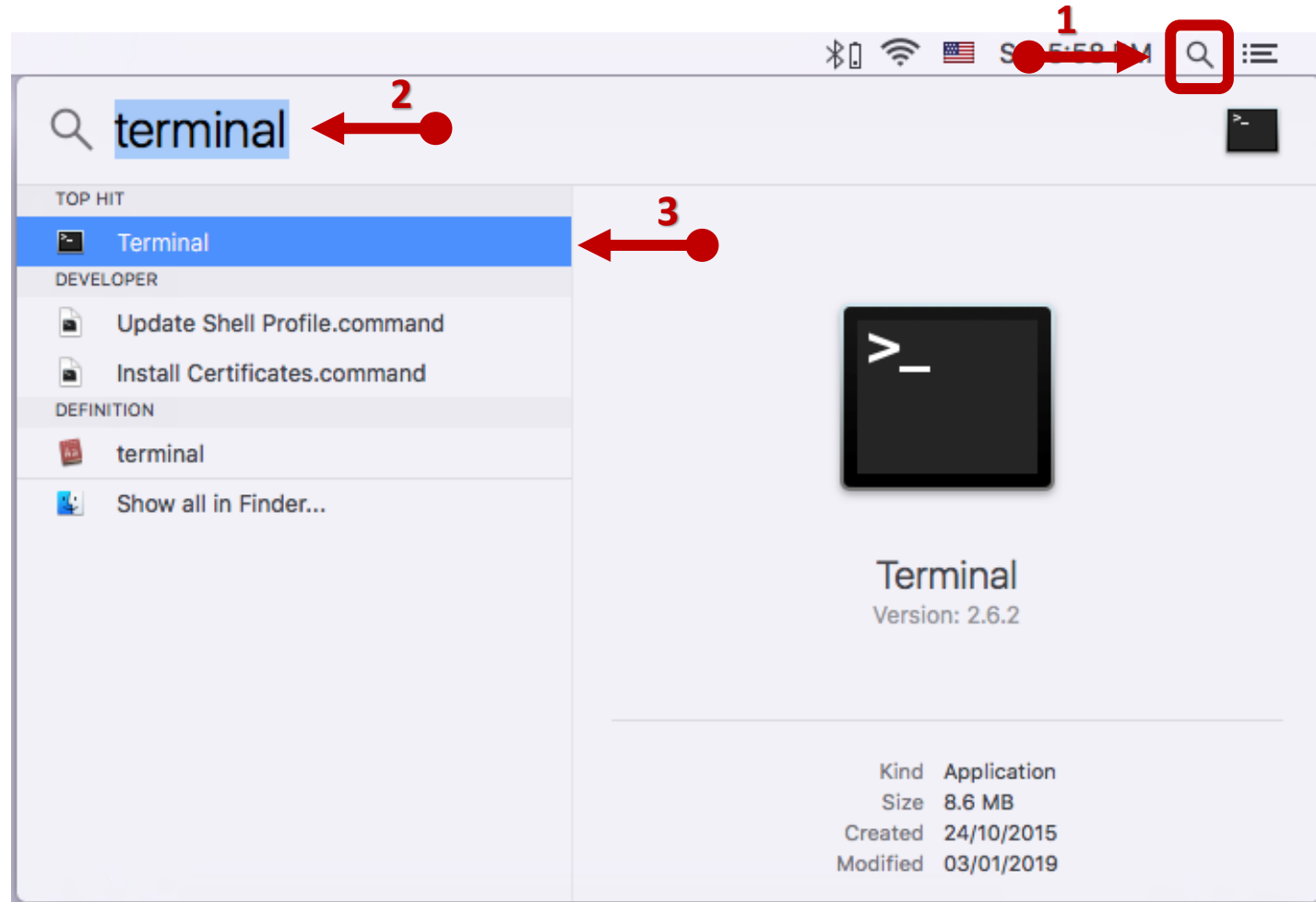
# Python Installation

- Type **Terminal**
- Click on **Terminal**






# Python Installation - Checking

- On the black screen that opened type `python3 --version`



```
iMac20 — -bash — 80x24
PiniAltlersiMac:~ iMac20$ python3 --version
```

- Press `Enter`
- You should get a text with the word Python and the number of the version you installed



```
iMac20 — -bash — 80x24
PiniAltlersiMac:~ iMac20$ python3 --version
Python 3.7.3
```

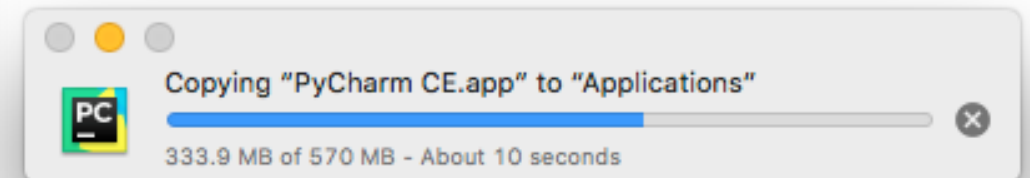
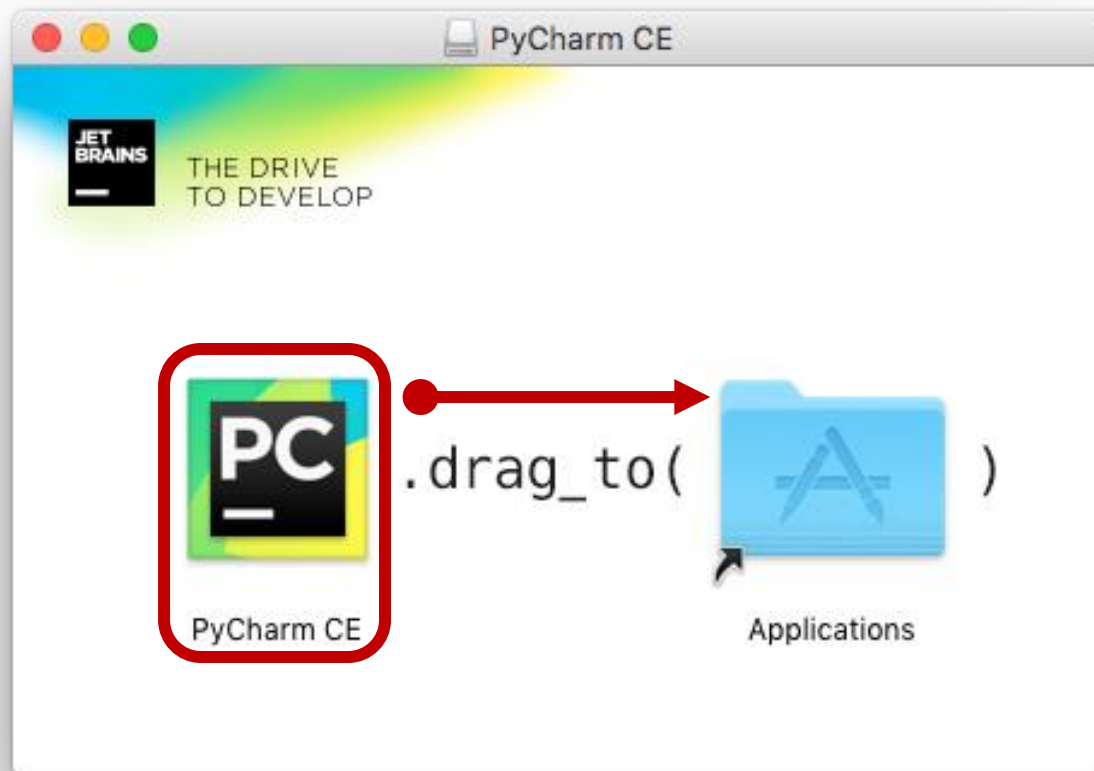
# PyCharm Installation

- Open this [link](#) and download the last version of **Pycharm** development environment

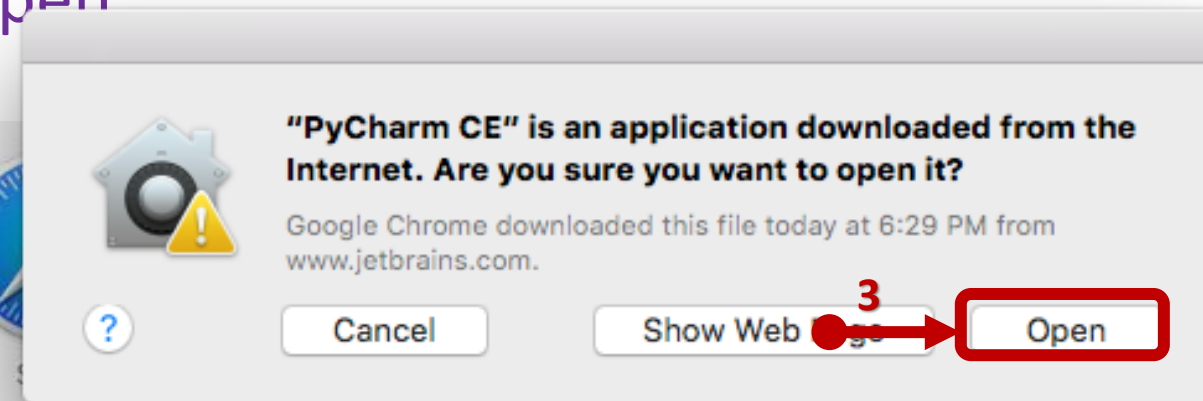
# PyCharm Installation

- Open the file you downloaded
- Drag **PyCharm CE** to the **Applications** shortcut, and drop.



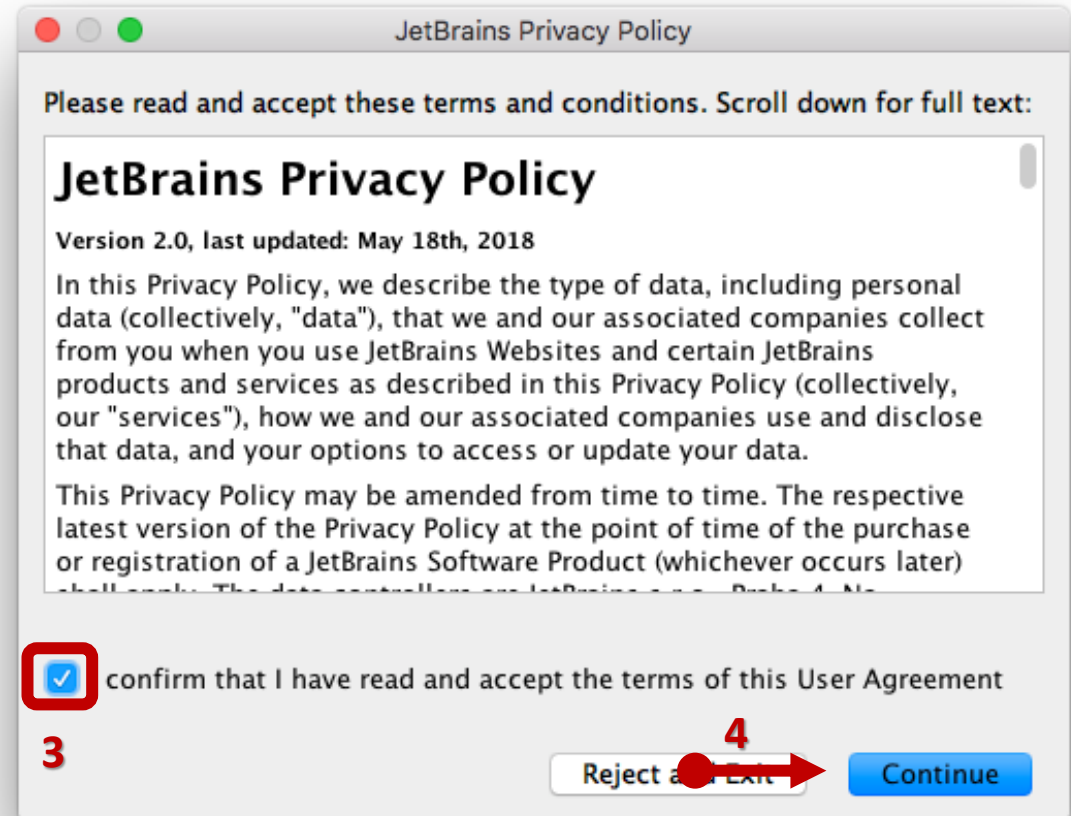
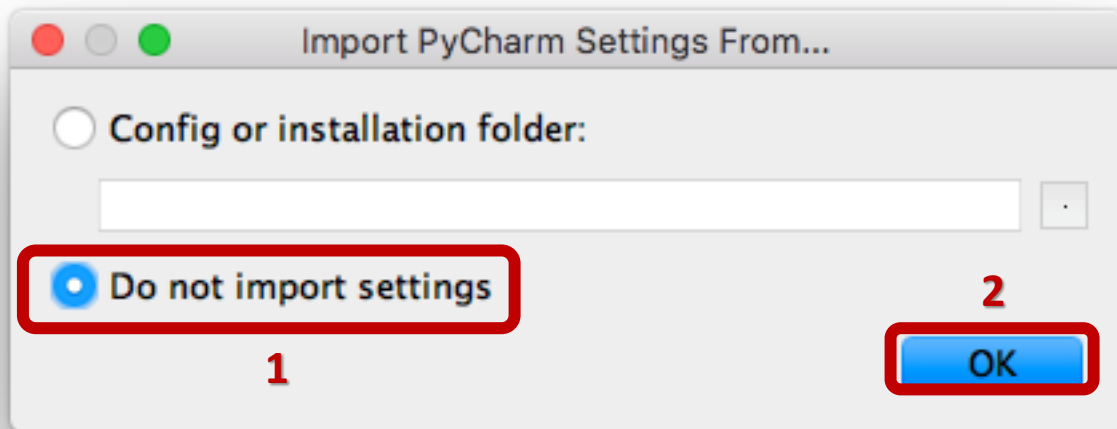
# PyCharm Settings

- Open the Applications folder and click on PyCharm CE
- In the window that opened choose **Open**



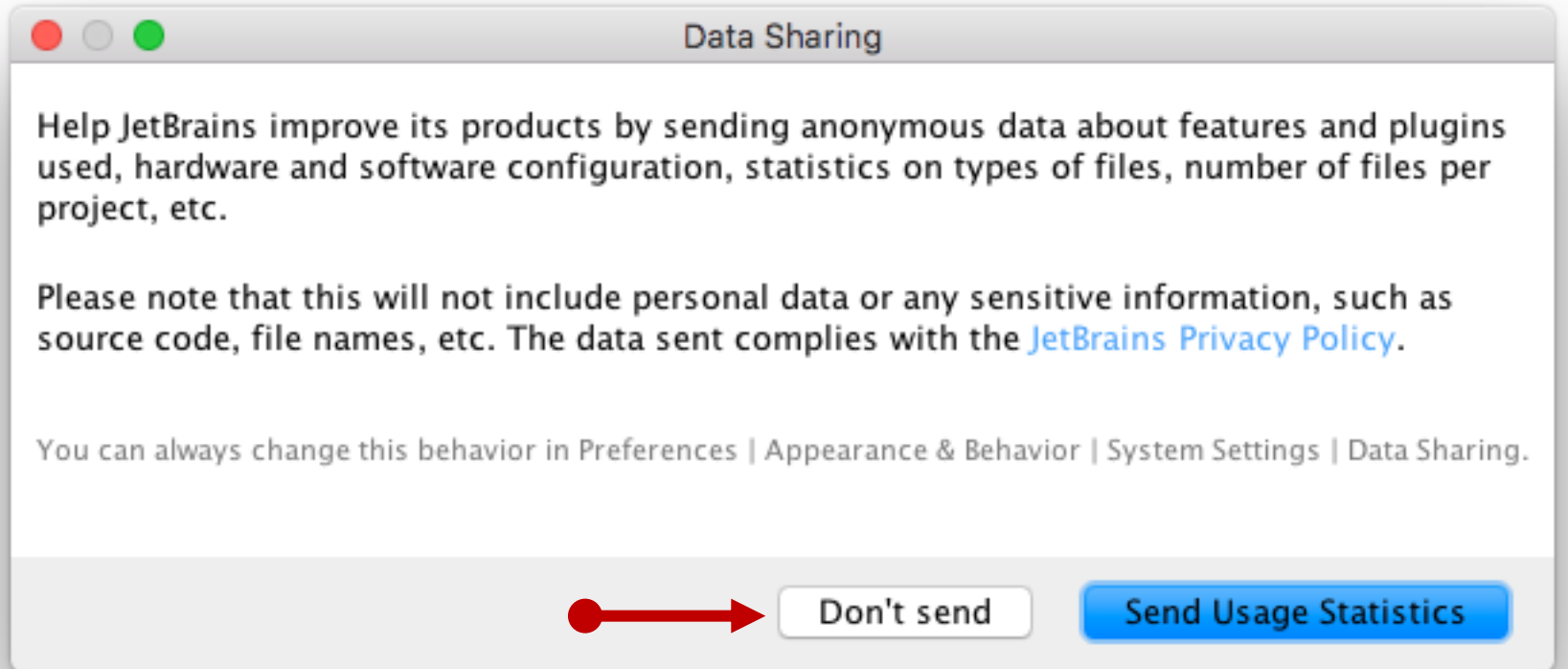
# PyCharm Settings

- Mark the option **I confirm that...** and click **Continue**



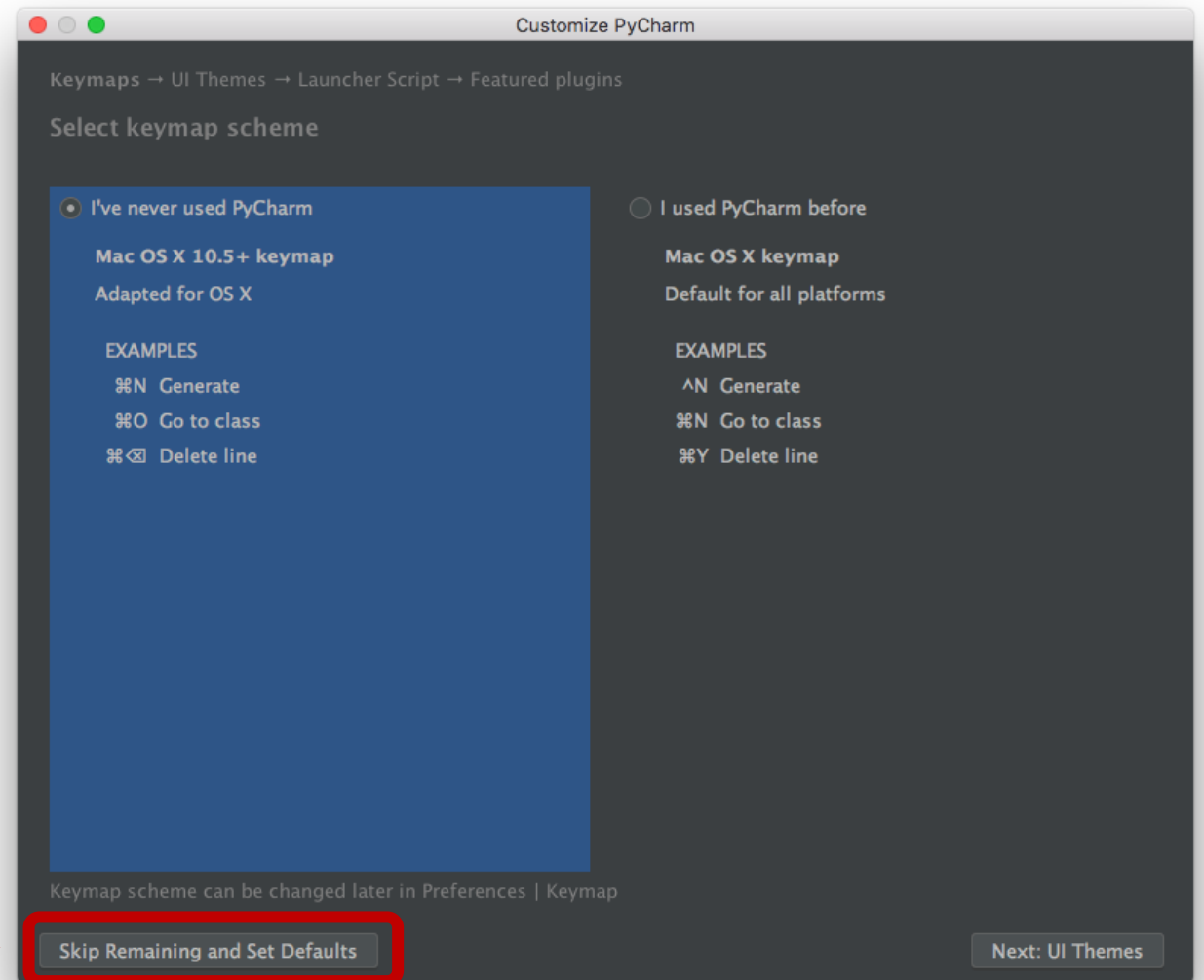
# PyCharm Settings

# PyCharm Settings

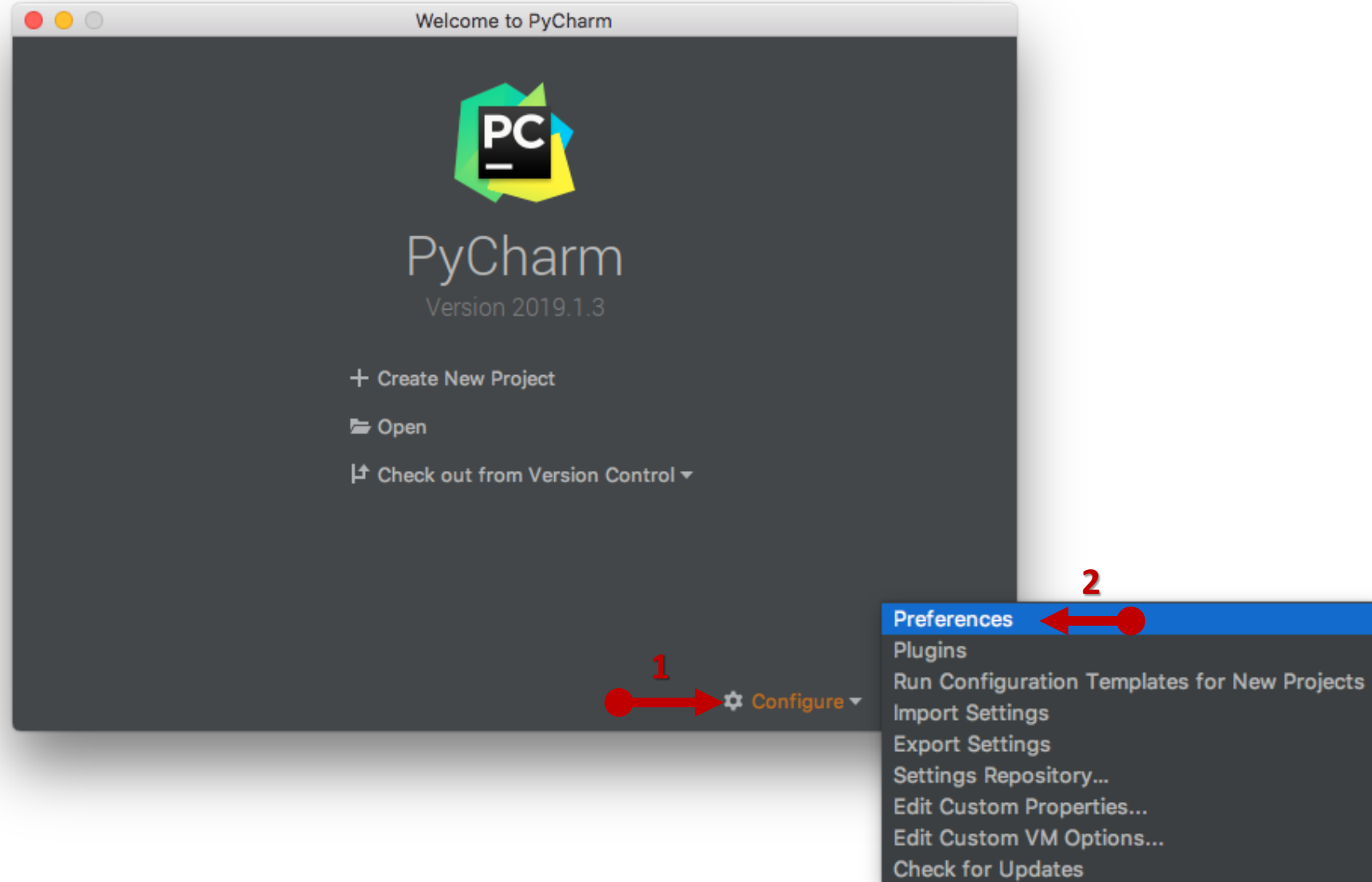
- Press Skip Remaining...





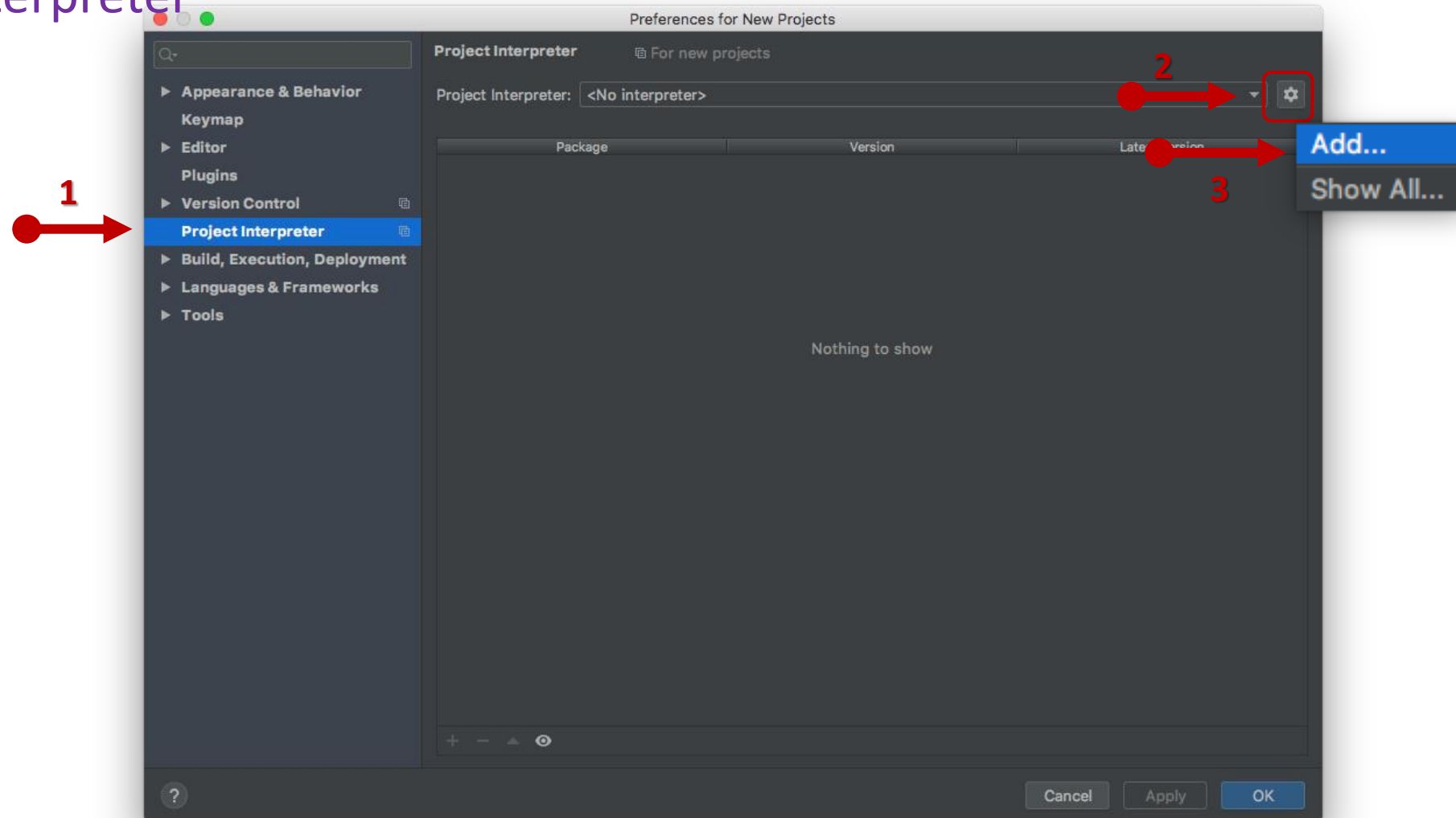
# PyCharm Settings

- Choose **Preferences**



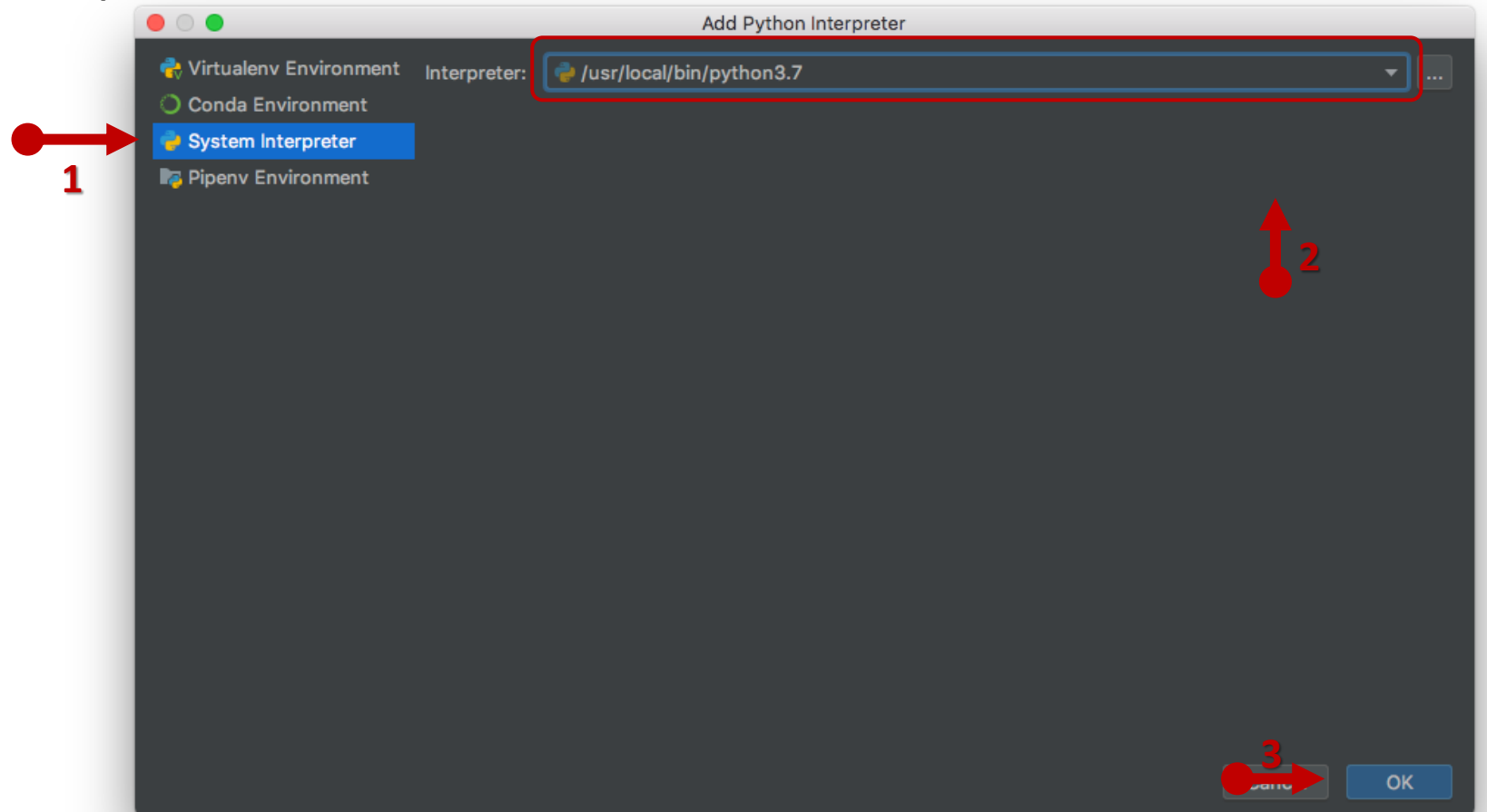
# PyCharm Settings

- Choose Add...



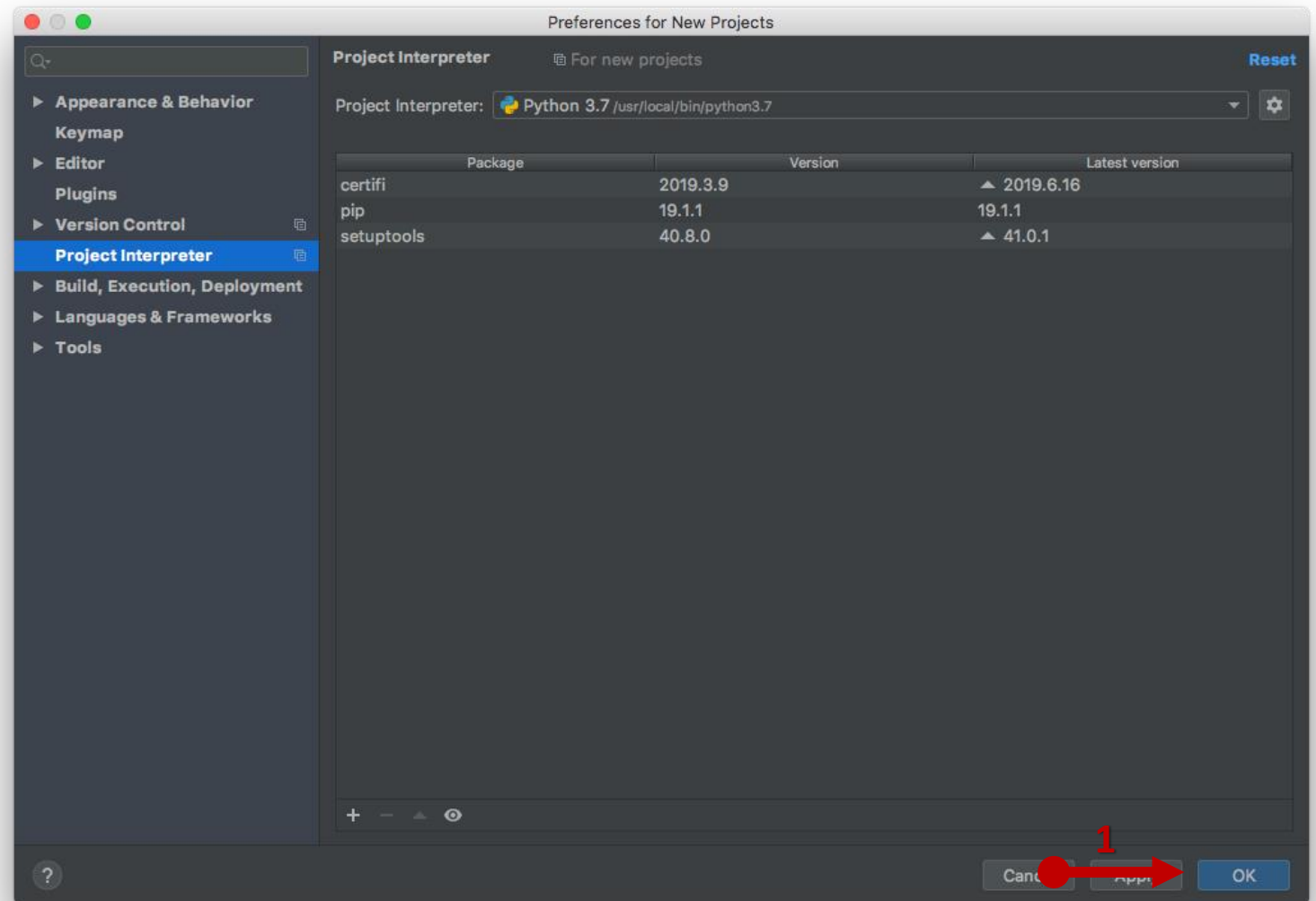
# PyCharm Settings
